



Building Coalitions

INTENDED AUDIENCE: Middle management and supervisors

This is 6-hour workshop will lead participants through an interactive discovery process of what it takes to build coalitions within the area and to build coalitions internally and with other Federal agencies, State and local governments, nonprofit and private sector organizations, foreign governments, or international organizations to achieve a common goal.

Goals:

Political Savvy – Identifies the internal and external politics that impact the work of the organization. Perceives organizational and political reality and acts accordingly.

Influencing/Negotiating – Persuades others; builds consensus through give and take; gains cooperation from others to obtain information and accomplish goals.

- Review 5 keys to resetting our rhythm


